Applications for entry in September 2018 are now welcome. We draw students from a large area of Lincolnshire, North East Lincolnshire and North Lincolnshire.

Entry is normally at 11+ but some places are available for older applicants in Year 10 and the Sixth Form. Selection is based on verbal reasoning tests (11+ and 14+) and GCSE results (16+).
