School Visits (Non-residential)

In school time

- No charge.
- Voluntary contributions to be sought at the actual cost per child, unless subsidised by the school.
- In the event of insufficient support to meet the costs the visit will not take place.
- The school may wish to exercise discretion in exceptional cases.

Out of school time

- Full charge to be made unless subsidised by the school.

School Visits (Residential)

In school time

- Board and lodging to be charged. Non-refundable deposits required.
- Voluntary contributions for additional expenses will be sought (transport, entrance fees etc).
- In the event of insufficient support to meet the costs, the trip will not take place.
- Adult helpers will not be charged. The cost will be met from Educational Visits budget.
- In cases of extreme hardship support will be given from school.
- The school may wish to exercise discretion in exceptional cases.

Out of school time

- Full charge to be made.
- Staff will not be charged.
- In cases of extreme hardship support will be given from school.
- The school may wish to exercise discretion in exceptional cases.

Swimming

No charge. Costs to be met by the Local Authority and school.

Coursework Materials

No charge. Cost to be met by the school.

In School Music Peripatetic Tuition

- Music tuition will take place only when parents undertake to meet the cost of sheet music, repairs to instruments and instrument insurance.
- A termly charge to help offset the tuition cost to be made.
- In cases of extreme hardship the school may wish to exercise discretion.

Extra-Curricular Music

- Contributions towards full cost of music and provision of instruments may be sought from parents.
- In cases of extreme hardship the school may wish to exercise discretion.

Special Events (for example, theatre companies, educational visitors)

- No charge.
- Voluntary contributions to be sought based on the actual cost per child unless subsidised by school.
- In the event of insufficient support to meet the costs the special event may not take place.

Breakages and Damage

Parents will be required to meet the cost of breakages to property where this is the result of a pupil's behaviour.
