Introduction

Crosby Primary School encourages children to wear our affordable school uniform, designed for practicality and safety. Those requiring financial support to adhere to the uniform policy should contact our Family Support Worker, Miss Michelle Allcock.

School Uniform

- Bottle green school cardigan or jumper
- Yellow or white polo shirt
- Grey or black skirt/pinafore *or* grey/black trousers/shorts (not jeans)
- Green and white or yellow and white print summer dress
- Sensible black shoes or boots
- Jewellery – one pair of stud earrings and a suitable watch may be worn (not to be worn on PE or swimming days)
- Long hair should be tied back
- No nail varnish
- Head scarves and hair accessories to be plain and school colours (white, black, grey, green or yellow)
- Tights to be plain and school colours

School PE Uniform

Children should come to school in PE kit on PE days.

- Black Shorts/leggings/jogging bottoms, white T shirt, bottle green school cardigan or jumper, plimsolls (trainers permitted if outdoor)
- Safe head scarves and hair accessories to be plain and school colours (white, black, grey, green or yellow), to be removed at the Teacher's discretion subject to activity
- Long hair tied back
- Earrings must be removed for PE lessons or taped over (this should be done by the parent/carer before school or by the child in school)

School Swimming

- One piece swimming costume
- Leggings/tops may be worn for modesty purposes
- No jewellery – earrings to be removed
- Long hair should be tied back
- No nail varnish
