### **Early Bird Club**

### **Breakfast Club**



Breakfast (bagels and juice or milk) is available every day for all children at no cost to parents/carers. This is served in the classroom.

### **School Day Times**

With the exception of Ladybird Class (Nursery), all classes will be able to come into school from **8:40am** and all doors will close at **8:55am**.

**If your child arrives at school after 8:55am please bring them to the main office and sign them in. Your child will be marked as late so please try to be on time!** Children in EYFS and Years 1 and 2 will finish school at **2:55pm** and Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 will finish school at **3:00pm**.

## **Attendance**

Many of our children have a good attendance record. However, we would like to take this opportunity to remind parents of our attendance procedures.

By law, parents and carers are responsible for ensuring that children attend school regularly and failure to do so may result in a referral to the local authority and ultimately prosecution.

We understand that there will be times when your child has to miss school because they are ill, please contact the school office on the first day of absence before 9am to inform the school of the reason for your child's absence and give an expected return date. A message itself does not authorise the absence; only if the school is satisfied as to the validity of the explanation will the absence be authorised.

We understand that children may have to attend medical appointments in school time (though please ask if they can be made outside school hours) but routine appointments should be made out of school time. Most appointments will not require a full day of absence from school.

## **Leave of Absence**

Children are in school for 190 days each year. There are 175 days when children are not required. Leave of absence from school, when not illness, should be requested by parents.

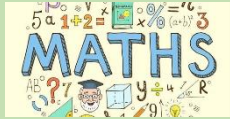
Leave of absence can only be granted in exceptional circumstances. Leave for a family holiday is not considered exceptional. An application should be made in advance and these can be obtained from the school office. Retrospective consent cannot be granted. Parents or carers will be issued with a penalty notice by North Lincolnshire Council if absence is not authorised.

Please work with us if there are attendance concerns, we want to give all children every opportunity to reach their full potential. Regular absences lead to your child missing large amounts of their education and may cause them to fall behind with their peers.
