Sun Safety 1

Key Vocabulary

Sun – light and warmth comes from the sun

Ultra Violet Radiation - we can't see or feel it on our skin but can damage our skin if we get too much of it.

Harm – injury or damage

Harmful – causes harm

Burn – an injury caused by heat

Shade – shelter from sunlight

Sunscreen – cream or lotion rubbed on the skin to protect it from the sun.

Sun Protection Factor (SPF) – describes the strength of the sunscreen
