As part of our topic on evolution, we have arranged a visit to **Yorkshire Wildlife Park**. This is an exciting opportunity for your child to learn about this topic through a hands-on workshop organised by the staff and to relate their learning to the animals they will see.

The dates of the visits are:

- Eagle Class Monday 15th May
- Kestrel and Hawk Classes Wednesday 17th May
- Owl and Falcon Classes Thursday 18th May

The coach will leave school at 9:15am, children should arrive at school at normal time. (Early Bird Club will still be available on these dates). Please ensure children have had breakfast and, if required, taken any travel sickness tablets beforehand. Travel sickness tablets for the return journey, along with any other medication, should be handed to the class teacher at morning registration. We anticipate our return time will be in time for the end of the day - we will send a text if we are late so please check your phone.

Your child will need to bring a packed lunch and suitable drink (school will provide this for children who would normally receive a free school meal). Your child will have to carry their packed lunch during the day so a back pack would be useful. School uniform and suitable school shoes must be worn. We will be outside all day so a rainproof coat should be brought in case of rain. If it is sunny, sun cream should be applied before coming to school and a sun hat is recommended.

With consideration of the cost of living crisis, we are heavily subsidising this visit and have managed to reduce the contribution to <u>£12.50</u> each. Whilst no child will be excluded on financial grounds, the visit may have to be cancelled if we do not receive enough money towards the cost.
