A very big thank you to Mrs Staple's father for making a beautiful plaque to go alongside the rose, in our Science Garden.






The School Council have a busy few weeks coming up.....

## **Telephoning school**


Please note that as a result of nuisance calls made to the school, we have blocked withheld telephone numbers
