

Attendance

Summary information can be found here: https://crosbyprimary.co.uk/attendance. The website can also be translated into different languages. Please read this information carefully so that you understand the expectations surrounding attendance.

The law entitles every child of compulsory school age to a full-time Education. It is the legal responsibility of every parent to make sure their child receives that education, this means that children must attend every day that the school is open, except in a small number of allowable circumstances such as being too ill to attend or being given permission for an absence in advance from the school. Our expectation for attendance is 100%. Missing school has a detrimental impact of children's learning, their life choices and hence opportunities in the future. Last year school attendance was only 90.5%, well below national expectations.

Please remember that requests for leave need to be made at least two weeks in advance and will only be granted in exceptional circumstances. Leave for a family holiday is not considered exceptional. In September 2013, the Education (Pupil Registration) (England) Regulations were amended to prohibit the Headteacher of a school granting leave of absence for a pupils except where an application was made in advance and the Headteacher considered that there were exceptional circumstances relating to the request. Forms can be obtained from the school office who will be pleased to help you complete them. They are also on the school website.

We ask that you please contact the school office on the first day of absence to inform the school of the reason for your child's absence and give an expected return date. You can just leave a message if you would like. We understand that children may have to attend medical appointments in school time (though please ask if they can be made outside school hours) but routine appointments should be made out of school time. Most appointments will not require a full day of absence from school. If we do not hear from you, then your child's absence will be marked as unauthorised. If school is not contacted, absences will be recorded as unauthorized. Where attendance is a cause for concern you may be required to provide evidence of absence. You may be asked to come to school for a meeting so that we can look at ways to help you and your child. Also, please be aware that unauthorised absences are referred to the Education Inclusion Service and a Penalty Notice or other legal action in relation to this matter may be taken.

Please note that if your child is absent from school for 10 days without consent and discussions with the school, a referral to North Lincolnshire Inclusion will be made under our child absent from School procedures and you may lose your child's place.

We will continue to celebrate classes that have the best attendance in our weekly Celebration assembly we reward children that are in school for 100% each term and over the whole year. In addition, this year children who attend school each day for a week will be given a sticker and entered into a prize draw. Further, classes that have a high number of children with 100% attendance each week will be able to play our new Attendopoly game to help reward pupils and classes that have 100% attendance each week.

Please help us to help you by contacting school if you have any concerns regarding attendance. Mrs George (Attendance Assistant) or Mrs Allcock (Family Support Worker) as well as the class teacher will be happy to help.
