## Mathematics Medium Term Plan F2 Autumn Term

## Concept Sequence:

- Compare size - compare according to size a range of classroom objects. Compare.
- Compare mass - introduce/model balance scales. Explore large objects that are light and small objects that are heavy.
- Compare Capacity - explore different containers and boxes. Fill different containers in the water area. Which holds the least/most?
- Explore simple patterns - explore simple examples to develop understanding of the word and concept. Look for patterns in the environment eg. spots, stripes, checks.
- Copy and continue simple patterns -AB patterns. My turn/your turn activities. Ensure three full units ABABAB. Look at horizontal/vertical patterns.
- Create simple patterns - use AB patterns - use a range of shapes, colours, actions and sounds. Spot errors in AB patterns - fix the problem.
