School Lunches

From September 2024 the cost of a school lunch will be increasing by 30p.

Crosby Primary School will subsidise some of the cost of this by 20p, leaving just a 10p increase for parents to pay.

So from September the daily cost of a school lunch will be **£2.60** per child, per day.

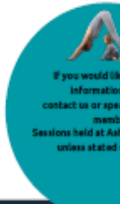
