### Incident update

I have had further information from the police following the incident in the community on 2nd July which I am now able to share with you. The policies and procedures in place that were followed by the school staff, ensured all children were kept safe during the incident.

Once again the police praised the school staff for their vigilance, timely action and co-operation. I would like to pass on my thanks for your patience and understanding during what has been a very difficult situation for us all.



### **Penalty Notice Fines for School Attendance are Changing**

A new **National Framework for Attendance** has been issued by the Department for Education which begins on 19<sup>th</sup> August 2024. In particular, there are changes to School Penalty Notice Fines issued after 19<sup>th</sup> August 2024 which we would like to make you aware of.

**First Offence:** The first time a Penalty Notice is issued for unauthorised absence the amount will be: £160 per parent, per child, paid within 28 days. This is reduced to £80 per parent, per child, if it is paid within 21 days.

**Second Offence (within 3 years of the first offence):** The second time a Penalty Notice is issued for unauthorised absence the amount will be: £160 per parent, per child paid within 28 days.

Third Offence and Any Further Offences (within 3 years of the first offence): The third time an offence is committed a Penalty Notice will not be issued and the case could be presented straight to the Magistrate's Court. Prosecution can result in Criminal records and fines of up to £2,500. Cases found guilty in Magistrates' Court may show on any parent's future DBS certificate for to 'failure to safeguard a child's education'.

Please note that penalty notices are issued per parent, per child ie. Penalty Notice Fines are issued to each parent, for each child that was absent. A Parent, according to section 576 of the Education Act 1996 is:

All natural (biological) parents, whether they are married or not.

Any person who, although not a natural parent, has parental responsibility for a child or young person.

Any person who, although not a natural parent, has care of a child or young person.

Please note that it is for the school to determine whether an absence can be authorised, not a parent. Leave may only be granted in exceptional circumstances. Forms to request a leave of absence are available on the school website or from the school office. These should be completed at least two weeks in advance for consideration with supporting evidence. The government does not consider a need or desire for a holiday or other absence for the purpose of leisure and recreation to be an exceptional circumstance.


